

# SOP-DENGUE PREVENTION

ANX - B

## Fairways Commercial (FCP)

1. With the onset of summer, dengue mosquitoes begin to breed in open area. To prevent dengue, it is essential to eliminate the mosquitoes by preventing larva formation. Dengue larva breeds in clean and stagnant water. Coordinated efforts by DRGCC and CP owners/ tenant are required to keep fairways commercial free from dengue threat. This can be achieved by ensuring cleanliness and anti-dengue measures at fairways commercial as following;

**a. Duration of Dengue Season**

- (1) 1<sup>st</sup> March to 30<sup>th</sup> April
- (2) 15<sup>th</sup> July to 30<sup>th</sup> November

**b. FCP Maint Office Responsibilities**

- (1) Daily cleaning of fairways commercial area including basements, mosque, CPs verandah and open area.
- (2) Fog spray in FCP.
- (3) Ensure non-accumulation of water at any down points of sitting area, piazzas and area around trees.
- (4) Incase of standing water, use of temephos powder to avoid dengue larva production.
- (5) Proper cleaning of dust bins, equipments, drums, pots and garbage area will be ensured by the cleaning team for the prevention of dengue in the premises of fairways commercial.
- (6) Use of Temephos powder in fountain water tanks.
- (7) After every rain during dengue season Asstt Manager will ensure the inspection of fairways commercial to avoid water accumulation at any corner.
- (8) The Asstt Manager will conduct awareness session to the employees/ workers of fairways commercial regarding dengue control.
- (9) Visit of under modification CPs to ensure anti dengue measures.
- (10) Security staff to use approved insect repellents on exposed skin.
- (11) Conduct Govt dengue team visit for inspection of anti-dengue measures at fairways commercial.
- (12) Display Govt anti dengue instructions (panaflex) at appropriate locations in fairwasys commercial area.
- (13) Ensure anti-dengue spray (Guardian) twice a week at following location of fairways commercial.

- (a) Basement area
- (b) 3 x Offices
- (c) Mosque
- (d) 3 x Electrical panel rooms
- (e) Fountain tanks
- (f) Public washrooms

c. **Owner/ Tenant Responsibilities**

(1) **Commercial Plazas**

- (a) Daily cleaning of CP
- (b) Organize anti-dengue spray in CP at least once a week.
- (c) All CPs owner/ tenant will ensure no standing water in planters inside CP.
- (d) Ensure no bird pots at roof top.
- (e) Ensure drainage of AC drain into drainage system.
- (f) Install window and door screens/ nets to block mosquito entry.
- (g) Cooperation with Govt dengue team during inspections.
- (h) Roof top cleaning and no garbage on roof top.

(2) **Outdoor Sitting**

- (a) Use of mosquito repellents.
- (b) Resort to minor fumigation measures.
- (c) Ensure non-accumulation of water in outdoor sitting area.
- (d) Ensure no standing water in planters placed in open area.
- (e) Use of air cooler and pedestal fans.
- (f) Water used in air coolers at outdoor sitting be replaced twice a week.

d. **Under Renovation CPs**

- (1) Try not to let water accumulate in the basement.
- (2) Sump pumps and dewatering must be installed so that water can be removed immediately if it accumulates.
- (3) Underground water tanks should be covered.
- (4) When applying water to bricks and walls, ensure non-accumulation of water.
- (5) Construction waste/ debris be removed without wastage of time.
- (6) If water pipes are leaking from anywhere, they should be repaired immediately.
- (7) Spray mosquito repellent at site to prevent dengue mosquitoes.
- (8) Ensure use of repellents by labour.
